Guidelines

SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

All applicants are considered case by case, however given the large number of applications, it is not possible to offer Scholarships to everyone who applies.

An interview will be arranged with the Head of College (or delegate) for short listed applicants only.

A family may be asked to provide details of a referee, which may be a coach or a teacher or tutor who would be able to endorse the applicant's diligence, ability and endorse the Scholarship application.

Scholarship Applications for students who excel in Music or the Arts may be required to submit a recording/portfolio of their work or may be required to attend an audition.

THE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION PROCESS AND OUTCOME IS HIGHLY CONFIDENTIAL

The Scholarship application process, the interview and the outcome is a highly confidential matter between the family and the Executive Principal.

Applications require the following supporting documentation:

- An Enrolment Application form (if the student is not a current MBBC student) – the Application Fee is waived
- A Scholarship Application form
- A covering letter to outline the family's reasons for applying for a Scholarship for their child/children
- Copies of two most recent school reports
- Copies of the student's NAPLAN results
- Resume of abilities, including detailed records of student involvement and achievement in their area/s of excellence. This would include qualified performance level, placement at competitions, State and/or National representation. It may also include documentation to demonstrate the student's service to the community or leadership position at their current school (if applicable).

All successful applicants:

- Must have an excellent record of behaviour and attitude
- Must have a proven high academic history
- Must be respectful of themselves and others at all times
- Must show resilience, determination and adaptability
- Must be willing to positively contribute to the co-curricular and service life of the College community and pursue opportunities which are presented to them
- Must possess and demonstrate ambition and motivation to achieve their goals
- Must comply with the College Code of Conduct and comply with the College expectations in terms of attitude, behaviour, uniform and digital citizenship

CONDITIONS OF SCHOLARSHIP

- Scholarship Eligibility does not automatically mean that a Scholarship will be offered.
- Scholarships are a % remission of the tuition fees.
- Each Scholarship is granted on the understanding that the Executive Principal has the right to withdraw the Scholarship if any of the above conditions are not met.
- Scholarships are contingent on the full disclosure of all information pertinent to a student's education and family situation. Withholding information may compromise the Scholarship.
- Potential withdrawal of a Scholarship for reasons relating to confidentiality breaches or dishonouring the Code of Conduct, will be discussed with the family prior to the end of a school term.
- Moreton Bay Boys' College has excellent pastoral care, counselling, learning support and learning enhancement programs and resources in place to assist students to reach their potential. Withdrawal of a Scholarship is not executed without due consideration of any mitigating circumstances, should any of the above conditions provide cause for concern. A Scholarship recipient would not ordinarily be withdrawn if the child becomes unwell or injured.
- In circumstances where a family withdraw the student from the College for reasons other than ill health, employment transfer, family relocation or other reasons as negotiated with the Executive Principal or his delegate, the family will be required to repay the financial benefit of the Scholarship percentage received from commencement to the conclusion of the student's enrolment. The penalty fee for insufficient notice may also be imposed, if a family does not honour the notice period. A family should communicate this as soon as possible with the College.
- Following the annual review of a Scholarship, the family will receive a letter from the College to confirm the continuation of the Scholarship for the following year. If there is a concern regarding a student on a Scholarship, this would be noted in this communication.
- All Scholarships are granted or withdrawn at the discretion of the Executive Principal.
- No further correspondence will be entered into with regard to the process or the outcome of an application.
- The Colleges reserve the right to make changes to this policy at any time.
- Enrolment Application Fees and Confirmation Fees may be adjusted at the discretion of the Executive Principal.
- Siblings of a Scholarship Recipient at the reciprocal College are entitled to the relevant sibling discount.
