All applicants will be assessed using the following selection criteria:

- Leadership/personal qualities
- Participation as a team member
- Peer and group respect
- Ability and willingness to serve
- Reliability, punctuality and ability to meet deadlines
- Ability to work co-operatively with peers and staff
- Ability to set realistic and manageable goals
- Capacity to accept responsibility and consistently complete tasks reliably and effectively

- Primary School applications will close on Friday 28 October 2016.
