Housekeeping

There is much activity behind-the-scenes as preparation for Phase 1 of the amalgamation continues. Over the next two weeks, meetings of administrative staff across both Colleges will be held so more detailed planning can occur. Planning for Registrars, Marketing and Finance staff is also progressing well and meetings will occur before the end of May.

The next in a series of sessions with senior staff on change management will occur next week. This will focus specifically on helping leaders to support their teams as we transition through the amalgamation process.

We are also currently amending the MBC and MBBC constitutions at a governance level and the new College boards will be appointed at the end of the term. As part of the amalgamated structure, the new representatives will be elected from the existing MBBC and MBC boards.
