## MBBC Student Recognition

Moreton Bay Boys College is committed to recognising and celebrating excellence in student achievement and/or participation in the life of the College.

The College Student Recognition program is designed and intended to reward and recognise committed effort, service and achievement of excellence from students in various areas of College life.

Moreton Bay Boys College will recognise excellence under the following categories:

- Academic
- Cultural
- Service
- Sport

**Students** enrolled in **Years 10 to 12** are **eligible** to be awarded or apply for recognition; based on accomplishments made at MBBC from the start of Year 7.

## MBBC Pockets

There will be 3 levels of recognition that are reflected in the design of the pocket to be worn on the College blazer:



Blue pocket



White pocket



Gold pocket

The pocket may be embellished with embroidery below to recognise the year in which particular excellence was demonstrated in one or more of the four categories.

# Student Recognition Points Requirements

## MBBC Pockets:

Blue	White	Gold
1000 points	1500 points	2000 points

## Category Recognition:

Categories are: Academic, Cultural, Service, Sport

300 points are required within a category for specific mention to be made of this achievement in the first instance (applications may be submitted at the end of Year 9).

Achieving 100 points in a category in a Senior year, will be awarded with special mention.

# Student Recognition Points

- Points can be accumulated from the start of Middle School (Year 7)
- First submission for recognition can be made at the end of Term 1 for Year 10
- Only the highest level of achievement will be recognised in exclusive situations (e.g. a Champion Player will be awarded 50 points only, not an extra 30 points as a Team member)
- Grade Point Averages (GPA's) are calculated from report card results using the following values:

Grade	A+	A	A-	B+	B	B-
Value	15	14	13	12	11	10

The lowest grade from each student's grade list is omitted in the calculation and is termed a 'grace' subject.

Receiving a 'fail' mark in any subject makes a student ineligible for Academic Achievement points.

## **MBBC Student Recognition Sub-Committee**

A Student Recognition Sub-Committee, chaired by the Deputy Head of College, will be established for:

- Writing and reviewing the policy.
- Reviewing the criteria for the award of pockets.
- Maintaining a consistency across the various categories with regard to awarding pockets.
- Recommending to the Principal the names of the recipients for the various levels of pockets.

## **Application for Student Recognition**

1. Students are eligible to apply for recognition from the end of Term 1, Year 10, then at the semester breaks in their Senior years.

Application deadline for first round:

2 June 2014

2. Applicants will need to complete a Student Recognition application form. This can be obtained from the College website or from Student Reception.
3. Complete the application, ensuring all sections are complete. Referees must be listed for each achievement. This is an MBBC staff member (or appointed person) who can verify the level of commitment and/or achievement is worthy of recognition.
4. Completed applications will be reviewed and assessed by the Student Recognition Sub-Committee.
5. A recommendation will be made to the Principal. The Principal will have the right to veto a recommendation.
6. The student will be notified of the decision in writing.
7. Students will be issued with an official voucher that can be presented to the Uniform Shop, with the student's blazer, for embroidery.

## **Special Consideration**

A written application for special consideration can be made to the Student Recognition Sub-Committee if a student's achievements are not contained within the Student Recognition Points Overview table.
